Agri SA Stel Transformasieverslag Bekend

Agri SA se lede het R331 miljoen op transformasie in die 2016/17 boekjaar spandeer en daardeur 108 307 begunstigdes geraak, waarvan meer as 55 000 nuwe boere is. Die 2018 Agri SA Transformasieverslag sluit in die verskeie projekte waarby bedryfslede, provinsies en korporatiewe lede by betrokke was. Die opname verslag en bykomende navorsing het ook die geleentheid gegee om krities die uitdagings tot transformasie te identifiseer, waarvan 'n tekort aan kapitaal heel bo aan die lys is.

Die 2018 Agri SA Transformasieverslag is die eerste gekonsolideerde verslag oor transformasie in landbou.

Agri SA se Transformasieverslag het ten doel om transformasie binne landbou te bevorder. Dit word gedoen deur beste praktyke, geleenthede vir verdere groei en oplossings vir ontwikkelings-uitdagings te identifiseer. Die opname onder ontwikkelingsprogramme vir boere rus Agri SA toe om die regering en ander belanghebbers pro-aktief oor die werk wat gedoen is en die uitdagings wat bestaan op te dateer. Die verslag is 'n erkenning van die suksesse wat deur vennootskappe bereik kan word.

“Die 2018 Transformasieverslag is ‘n uitstekende vertrekpunt om die belangrike gesprek rondom transformasie te voer,” sê Christo van der Rheede, Agri SA Adjunk Uitvoerende Direkteur. “Daar is ‘n groot mate van energie binne die landbousektor om transformasie te laat werk, maar ons moet ook seker maak die hulpbronne wat na daardie doel vloei tot werklike volhoubare boerderye lei.”

Agri SA Releases Transformation Report

The Agri SA membership has spent R331 million on transformation in the 2016/17 financial year and reached an estimated 108 307 beneficiaries, of which includes 55 000 farmers. The 2018 Agri SA Transformation Report includes several projects which includes commodity members, provinces and corporates members that have been involved. The survey report and additional research also gives the opportunity to critically identify challenges to transformation, of which a shortage of capital is at the top of the list.

The 2018 Agri SA Transformation Report is the first consolidated report on transformation within agriculture.

Agri SA's Transformation Report is geared towards promoting transformation in agriculture. This is done by identifying best practices and exploring opportunities for further growth and finding solutions to developmental challenges. The survey of farmer development programs enables Agri SA to proactively update government and other stakeholders on the work done and challenges that exist. The report is a recognition of the successes that can be achieved through partnerships.

“The 2018 Transformation Report is an excellent point of departure to have a discussion on transformation,” said Christo van der Rhee, Agri SA Deputy Executive Director. “There is a great deal of energy within the agricultural sector to make transformation work, but we must also ensure that the resources that flow towards these aims lead to truly sustainable farms.”
