### Kommersiële landbouprodusente in oorlewingstryd weens die droogte **Commercial farmers in drought stricken areas battling to survive**

### Kommersiële landbouprodusente in oorlewingstryd weens die droogte

Agri SA se kantoor word tans oorweldig deur versoeke vanaf uiters desperate kommersiële en opkomende landbouprodusente om droogtehulp. Ons doen dus 'n beroep op die korporatiewe sektor en algemene publiek om finansiële by te dra tot Agri SA se droogtehelpfonds vir die befondsing van voerpille en die vervoer daarvan na produsente in nood.

'n Ander groot probleem wat Agri SA ondervind is dat 'n toenemende getal hoogs produktiewe en suksesvolle kommersiële produsente tans sukkel om kop bo water te hou. Ons doen 'n beroep op kommersiële banke en agribesighede om maniere te vind om grootskaalse bankrotskappe onder hierdie produsente te verhoed. Ons vra ook dat die regering hulp verleen aangesien hierdie produsente 'n belangrike rol speel om voedsel op groot skaal vir die kommersiële mark te produseer.

Dit is veral produsente in dele van die Noord-Kaap, Vrystaat en Noordwes, Oos-Kaap en Wes-Kaap wat 'n ernstige krisis in die gesig staar en dringend finansiële hulp benodig. Hulle kan nie langer bekostig om veevoer aan te koop nie en het nie die nodige kontant om hul boerderye aan die gang te hou nie. Boorgate op baie plase het ook begin opdroog en diere is besig om te vrek. Plaaswerkers en hul gesinne het ook dringend humanitêre hulp nodig.

Die voortdurende droogte in dele van Suid-Afrika het 'n geweldig negatiewe en vernietigende impak op sosio-ekonomiese omstandighede in baie landelike gemeenskappe. Die verlies aan 'n toenemende getal kommersiële produsente wat die ruggraat van ekonomiese groei en werkskepping uitmaak, sal bloot die armoede en werkloosheid in hierdie gebiede vererger.

Agri SA doen 'n beroep op die korporatiewe sektor en die algemene publiek om by te dra tot Agri SA se droogtehelpfonds aangesien ons produsente nou meer as ooit tevore ons hulp nodig het.

## Commercial farmers in drought stricken areas battling to survive

Agri SA's office is currently inundated with calls for drought relief assistance from very desperate commercial and emerging farmers. We therefore call on the corporate sector and public to contribute financially to the Agri SA drought relief fund in order to finance the purchasing of feed pellets and the transportation thereof to farmers in need.

Another big concern to Agri SA is the fact that more and more highly productive and successful commercial farmers are struggling to make ends meet. We appeal to our commercial banks and agri businesses to find ways and means to prevent large scale bankruptcies amongst these farmers. We also appeal to government for assistance as these farmers have played a crucial role to produce food on a large scale for the commercial market.

It's especially farmers in parts of the Northern Cape, Free State and North West, Eastern Cape and Western Cape that face a severe crisis currently and who are in desperate need for financial assistance. They can no longer afford to buy animal feed and lack the cash flow to keep farm operations going. Boreholes on many farms are also starting to dry up and animals are busy dying. Farm workers and their families also have a desperate need for humanitarian assistance.

The continuous devastating impact of the drought in parts of South Africa do have a very negative and destructive effect on the socio-economic fiber of many rural communities. Losing more and more of our commercial farmers who are the backbone of economic growth and job creation will just exacerbate the conditions of poverty and unemployment.

Agri SA is appealing to the corporate sector and the general public to contribute towards the Agri SA Drought Relief Fund because our farmers need our assistance now more than ever.
